The Board of Directors comprises of serving and retired naval officers and civilian members representing the General Body. The board of directors functions under Commander Coast as Chairman. Presently, Rear Admiral Moazzam Ilyas HI (M) is the chairman.

ACHIEVEMENTS

Education: The association introduced various schemes to help the deserving students of coastal areas which include:

- Free educational facility for the talented and needy students.
- Free uniforms, books stationery and fees for the academic year.
- Concession in fee and transport facilities for pick and drop teachers and students.
- Collection of used books, bags, uniforms from Bahria Colleges/Schools at Karachi and distribution among the needy students.
- Selection of students from remote areas of Balochistan and admit them in Bahria Schools/Colleges at Karachi with provision of free education, boarding and lodging facilities.

Distribution of ration bags: The association distributes items of daily commodities during the month of Ramadan to the bereaved families of the coastal and creek areas. Alhamdulillah! This year 3,449 ration bags amounting to Rs 7.2 M were distributed as Zakat.

Meat distribution: On Eid-ul-Adha, meat of 67 shares of Cows (9 Cows & 4 shares) and 7 goats were distributed to 1,000 families by SWA / Ulphat Foundation in Creek / Jati areas.

Health Facilities:

- Free health care services and medicines through Pakistan Navy hospital PNS Darman Jah and naval medical centres in the areas.
- Regular medical camps at Coastal and Creek areas where over 8000 patients are being treated by specialists each year.



SWA Ambulance: An Ambulance has been donated by ZVMG Rangoonwala Trust to SWA, which will be utilized for poor civil population of Ormara.

To visualize the futuristic needs of the area, PN along with SWA has planned an educational complex at Newtown Gwadar on a 15 Acres land. The important components of the educational complex are:

- **Bahria Model College Gwadar (under construction)**
- Vocational Training Centre
- Special Children School
- Separate Boys and Girls Hostels
- Faculty Accommodation
- Masjid and Sports fields (centralized)
- Auditorium and Library
- Shopping Area and Health care Centre
- Naval Pre-Joining Training Centre (For training/guidance of local students who wants to join Armed Forces).

CONSTRUCTION OF BAHRIA MODEL COLLEGE GWADAR (BMC)

In order to provide quality education to local population, construction of BMC Gwadar is in progress since March 2016 on 2.5 x acres.

The first phase of construction of Bahria Model College Gwadar includes 01 Admin and 02 Academic Blocks. The funds are required to complete the college as per project time line.
