LOCAL RULES – KARACHI GOLF CLUB

1. **Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16.1)**
 - a. All areas marked 'GUR' by white lines and/or by stakes. Play is prohibited from 'GUR'.
 - b. Any area dug up for repairs or improvements.
 - c. Any debris collected for removal.
 - d. Water channels formed by permanent irrigation units.
 - e. Service vehicles tyre ruts.
 - f. Tree Pits for watering.
2. **Abnormal Course Condition- Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16.1 & Local Rule 8E-1.2)**
 - a. Fixed Irrigation units, Drink Kiosks, Litter Receptacles.
 - b. Pump House - right side of Red Course Hole # 3.
 - c. Safety Nets on Blue Course Hole #s 5 & 9 and Red Course Hole # 2.
 - d. Electric Light Poles.
 - e. Stakes supporting trees - only if it interferes with a player's stance or the area of his/her intended swing (Local Rule 8F - 18).
 - f. 'Manufactured Water Tanks' - Blue Course Hole # 9 right side of green and Yellow Course Hole # 6 left side of fairway. Player may play the ball as it lies or take relief under Rule 16.1 or as an extra option take relief and play from the 'Drop Zone' (Local Rule 8E-1.2).
3. **Abnormal Course Condition – No Play Zone (Rule 16.1-f) Play Prohibited**
 - a. Protection of trees Identified by 'Black Band' - player MUST take relief.
 - b. Cactus on Red Course Hole #s 1, 4, and 9 - player MUST take relief and play from 'Drop Zone'.
4. **Out of Bounds (Rule 18)**
 - a. Beyond all walls, fences, white stakes and/or white lines defining boundary of the course.
 - b. Internal Out of Bounds - boundary is defined by white stakes and/or white lines.
 - i. Red Course Hole # 9 – behind the green.
 - ii. Blue Course Hole # 1 – left side of tee box.
 - iii. Blue Course Hole # 2 – left side of the hole.
 - iv. Blue Course Hole # 9 – Club House area left side and behind the green.
 - v. Yellow Course Hole # 14 – left side of the hole.
 - vi. Yellow Course Hole # 18 – Club House garden area behind the green.

5. **Drop Zones for Penalty Areas - Local Rule 8E-1.1 (to speed up play)**
 - a. Red Course Hole # 6 left side of fairway.
 - b. Yellow Course Hole # 13 right side of green marked by Red Stakes.
 - c. Yellow Course Hole # 14 right side of fairway marked by Yellow Stakes.
 - d. Yellow Course Hole # 15 behind the green – ONLY when playing Yellow Course Hole #15.
 - e. Yellow Course Hole # 16 for Penalty Area behind the green marked by Red Stakes only.
 - f. Yellow Course Hole # 17 front, right side, and behind the green.
6. **Provisional Ball for Ball in a Penalty Area - Local Rule 8B-3 (to speed up play)**

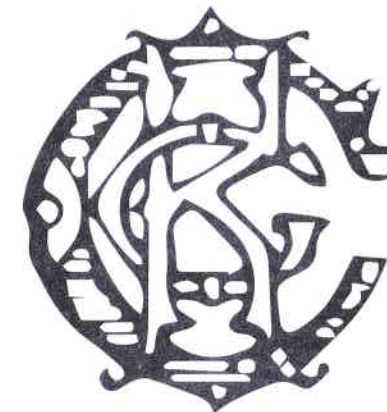
Red Course Hole # 6, Yellow Course Hole # 14, 16, & 17 Rule 18.3a is modified to give a player the option to play a provisional ball if he/she does not know for certain that his/her ball is lost in the Penalty Area. This Local Club Rule is for general play where golfers are playing casual rounds or playing their own competitions.
7. **Ball Out of Bounds or Ball Lost - Local Rule 8E-5 (to speed up play)**

Alternate to Stroke and Distance penalty, for a Ball Out of Bounds or Lost Outside a Penalty Area, a player may play his/her next shot, under penalty of 2 strokes, from the edge of the fairway not nearer to the hole to where the original ball is estimated to have crossed out of bounds or be lost, except tee shot when playing Yellow Course Hole # 14. This Local Club Rule is for general play where golfers are playing casual rounds or playing their own competitions.
